We make a commitment to the following:

We accept that we each have a responsibility for our contribution to global climate change and we resolve to hold each of our personal activities up to scrutiny.

We commit to changes in our habits and willingly embrace the discomfort that these actions might bring us.

We commit ourselves to continually educating ourselves about the issue of climate change and sharing that information with others.

Recognizing that one's personal desire to reduce one's contribution to climate change may exceed the means available, we commit to sharing and caring for each other.

We commit ourselves to communicating with legislators and others in a position of authority on a regular basis to voice our support for legislation that reduces carbon emissions and opposition to policies that exacerbate global warming.

We make a commitment to reduce our consumption of material goods, opting instead, when possible, to reuse already existing materials.

We commit to renewing ourselves in corporate discernment at Meeting for Business at least once each quarter.
