

# Power Line Route to be Decided Soon! Will Your Voice Be Heard In Time?



SCE will within weeks submit plans to build a 220,000 volt power line from Lemon Cove to Visalia. It will have towers that are 140 feet tall. There are multiple plans, but the most contentious route follows Hwy 198 criss-crossing over many homes, farms and preserves in Visalia, Farmersville, Exeter and Lemon Cove. Although a months-long permit process is expected, the most likely outcome is that SCE's primary route will be accepted by the CPUC.

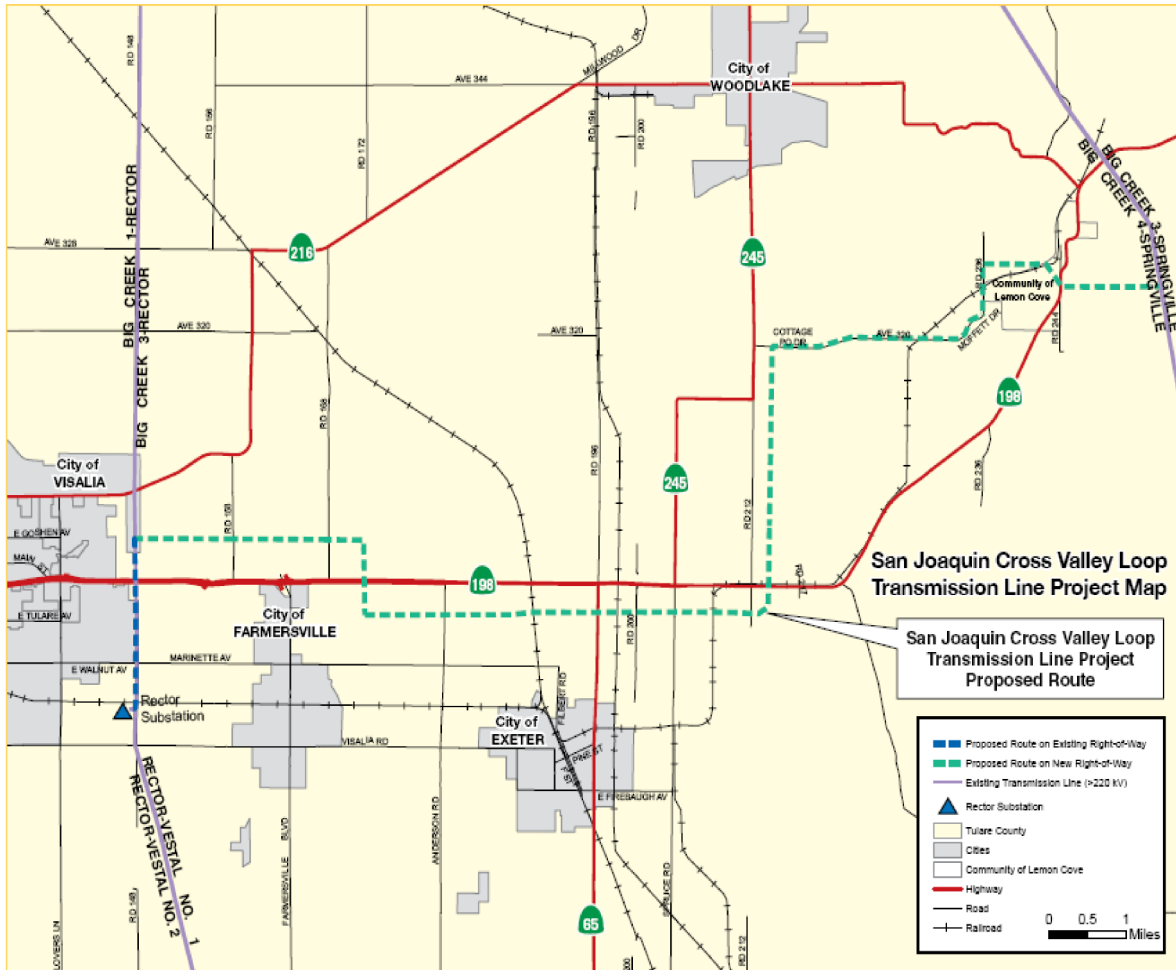
