POPLAR RIDGE MONTHLY MEETING FOR BUSINESS MINUTES FOR JULY 17, 2016

The Monthly Meeting opened with a period of worship about 11:45 p.m.

Attending were Ruth Ann Bradley, David Connelly, Anne Dalton, Robert Kight, Jeff Layton, A.T. Miller, Cathy Mullarney, Suzanne O'Hara, Andrew Simkin, Jane Simkin, and Paul Simkin.

Jane Simkin reported that the local library will use our Meetinghouse once more this summer, this coming Thursday.

She reports also that we need volunteer cleaning beginning in August.

Jeff Layton reported for the Finance Committee that a \$5,000 bequest from Alfred Jamison has been given to our Monthly Meeting for humanitarian and charitable purposes, not for travel or lodging, the meetinghouse capital improvements nor building maintenance. The Monthly Meeting accepts it and has agreed to use \$1,500 of it for our outside charities this year.

Jeff also reported that the Finance Committee has set up a separate \$10,000 fund for work in our basement and has used \$4,000 so far.

Anne Dalton and A.T. Miller reported that Rebecca Schillenback has suggested that we participate in the Genoa Wheat Harvest Festival August 6 in some way. We do not see a clear path to doing it this August and asks the Outreach Committee to consider plans for next year and other activities to spread our message and increase the visibility of our Meeting.

Poplar Ridge Friends Meeting (Quakers) requests that Camp Gregory's Super Heroes Themed week, the first week in August, include a peacemaking, social justice, or diversity element, and we offer assistance.

We read the minutes from the June 16 meeting and finished in silence at 1 p.m.
